EMS Agency Faxes

Recently, the EMS Agency, along with the entire County of San Luis Obispo Health Department, has switched from land-line based phones to a Cisco digital system. The switch has adversely affected our ability to consistently receive faxes. Base Station rosters, EMT and Paramedic certification/accreditation applications, and MICN authorization /reauthorization applications have historically been sent to the EMS Agency via fax. We ask that individuals and agencies send these forms in a digital format, in person, or by mail to the EMS Agency. This can be accomplished several different ways:

- A PDF fillable application from <http://www.sloemsa.org>
 - (a) Download the PDF to your desktop
 - (b) Fill out the form and save
 - (c) Attach the form to an email and send to mpinney@co.slo.ca.us
- Download the free Adobe Scan Application available for both IOS and Android
This app allows you to "scan" forms by using the camera on a smart phone and converts the scan to a PDF.
- Print the form and fill it out by hand then scan it to a computer
- Come by the EMS Office at 2180 Johnson Ave San Luis Obispo and drop the application off by hand on M, W, F 0900-1100 or call for an appointment (805)788-2519
